SCHOOL BOARD POWERS AND DUTIES

The School Board derives its authority to govern the local schools directly from the Wisconsin Constitution And state statutes. The Board also recognizes it has an obligation to the community it serves and the persons it employs to discharge its duties and obligations in a fiscally responsible way and in a manner that will best provided for the academic achievement of all students in the District.

The School Board shall do all things reasonable to promote the cause of education, including establishing, providing and improving school district programs, functions and activities for the benefit of students.

Specifically, the Board shall perform the duties imposed upon the Board by the statutes including, but not limited to:

- 1. levying taxes sufficient to support the schools;
- 2. overseeing the repair and use of buildings and grounds;
- 3. adopting policies necessary for the effective management of the district;
- 4. approval of professional staff employment;
- 5. adoption of academic standards;
- 6. support of professional development
- 7. properly managing school district funds.
