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Gifted and Talented Program

The River Valley School District shall strive to offer each student experiences appropriate to his/her individual needs, interests, and capabilities.

A gifted and talented program shall be established to provide the potentially high achieving students with an opportunity to develop skills in inquiry and creative expression at a rate and to an extent appropriate to his/her ability. "Gifted and talented students" shall include those students who give evidence of high performance capability in intellectual, creative, artistic, leadership, or specific academic areas and who need services or activities not ordinarily provided in a regular school program. Appropriate programming shall be provided for identified gifted and talented students. The Gifted and Talented Coordinators and building administration shall be responsible for the coordination of the program. Students shall be identified as gifted and talented in accordance with state guidelines. The identification process shall be responsive to such factors such as, but not limited to, students' economic conditions, race, gender, culture, native language, developmental differences, and identified disabilities as described in state education laws.

The Board shall review the gifted and talented program on a regular basis.
