Entrance Criteria for Kindergarten/First Grade

Children who meet the entrance age requirements shall be enrolled in kindergarten and/or first grade in the River Valley School District. A student cannot attend first grade unless he/she has attended kindergarten. Through Board policy, the district must establish procedures, conditions, and standards for exempting a child from the requirement that the child complete kindergarten as a prerequisite to enrollment in first grade.

No child may be admitted to kindergarten or first grade unless he/she is five or six years of age respectively on or before September 1 of the year he/she proposes to enter school, except as otherwise provided.

Early admission to kindergarten or first grade may be granted only in accordance with established procedures.

Notice of this policy and its implementing procedures shall be given annually via the school district newsletter.
