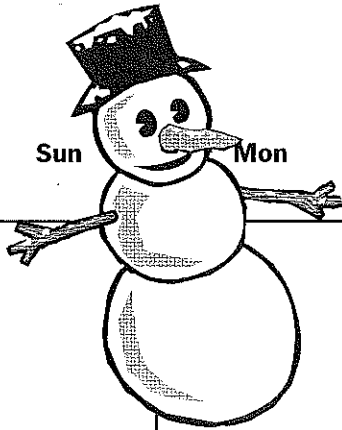

One immediate exception for not going outside would be if the wind-chill factor is at or below zero. We do expect all children to come dressed appropriately for outside play. This includes snow pants, boots, hats, waterproof/fleece gloves (the knit ones do not keep their hands warm or dry), warm winter coat, etc.




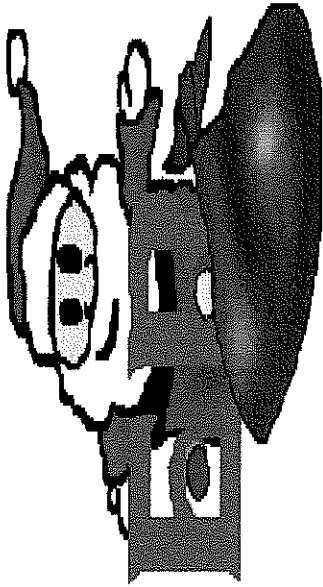
The older students especially tend to not want to wear all the recommended attire, we ask for parent help in encouraging them to do so.
