Spring Portraits

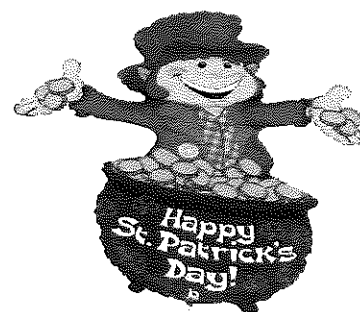

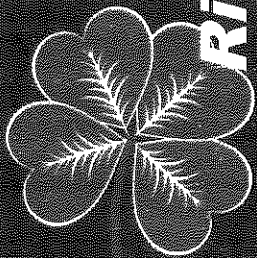
