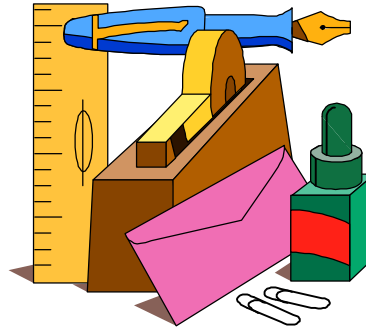


Plain Elementary School

Grade K/1

- DO NOT LABEL:

- 1 - box 16 count Crayola Crayons
- 1 - box 8 count Classic Crayola Markers
- 1 - blunt tip Fiskar child scissors
- 2 - Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 - 4 oz. bottle Elmer's school glue
- 1 - box facial tissue
- 1 - box baby wipes
- 1 - doz. sharpened plain #2 wooden pencils
- 1 - box snack OR quart OR gallon size Ziploc bags
- 1 - box snack crackers or cereal (whole wheat or lowfat) to be shared at milk break

- LABEL WITH NAME:

- 1 - pair Phy Ed tennis shoes (wear or bring on Phy Ed days)
- 1 - 2 pocket plastic folder (fun pictures ok)
- 1 - activity or coloring book for rainy days
- 1 - old adult size t-shirt
- 1 - Kindermat (optional for 1st grade)
- 1 - backpack 1 - change of clothes in plastic bag (all season pants, shirt, underpants, socks)

Grade 2

- Put name on everything!
- book bag
- 1 box magic markers (classic colors, not bold)
- 24 crayons (no more than 24)
- sharp scissors
- 6 sharpened pencils each 9 weeks
- wood or plastic 12" ruler (metric and inches) No bendable or foldable rulers
- 2 bottom pocket folders (no trapper keepers, no side pockets)
- Green pocket folder for Guidance
- large glue-all
- cloth or fabric pencil case (no boxes)
- 1 pink eraser and 5-10 eraser tips
- 1 large box of facial tissue
- 2 wide ruled notebooks
- large glue stick

Grade 5

- ruler
- scissors
- glue stick
- pencils-a must for math class
- large pink eraser
- black or blue pens-no gels pens
- red pens-a must for correcting (at least 2)
- small pencil case or box (ziplock bags work well)
- colored pencils (may also have markers but must have colored pencils for times when markers are too messy). Please, no crayons.
- 2 wide lined spirals or notebooks (they should be one subject notebooks only, approximately 70-100 pages).
- 2 folders (it may help to get different colors to match spirals)
- Green pocket folder for Guidance (can reuse from last year)
- 2 book covering materials (paper grocery bags)
- large box of facial tissue -a must, they are used quickly in winter
- No trapper keepers or 3 ring binders. School will provide a 3 ring binder.
- For computer skills class: Mrs. Hoffman will return your folder and notebook to you from grade 4. Bring a new folder and notebook only if you did NOT turn them in to Mrs. Hoffman in grade 4.

Grade 3/4

- Cloth or fabric pencil case (no boxes please)
- 2 bottles of white glue
- 2 large glue sticks
- sharp scissors
- ruler
- 1 box crayons (48 or less)
- 1 package colored pencils
- 1 package crayola markers
- 1 dozen sharpened pencils (plain, yellow, #2 pencils)
- eraser tops for pencils
- 4 black or blue pens (no gel pens please)
- paint shirt for Art class
- 1 box of tissue
- *Please do not label notebooks or folders
- 4 wide-ruled spiral notebooks; 70-100 pages (yellow, blue, green, red)
- 4 pocket folders (yellow, blue, green, red)
