

Academic Goal for the RVSD

This progress will be measured through the use of district and state assessments.

 - MLSS continued implementation (Universal + Selected + Intensive)
 - Small-group Instructional Strategies
 - Professional development and support in Curriculum Renewal and Design
 - Data analysis training

By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, 100% of River Valley School District students will be able to share the name of a trusted adult from the River Valley School District using observational, staff and survey data.

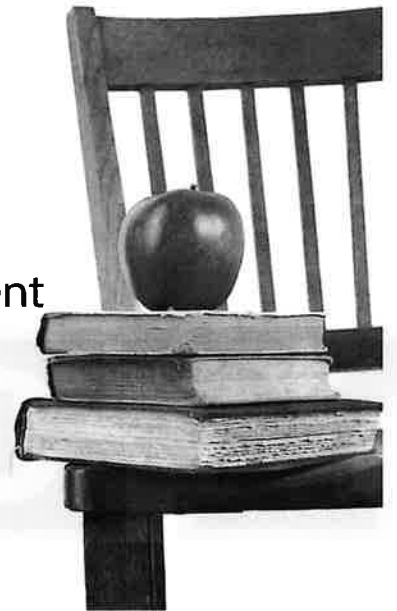
- Strategies that will be utilized to achieve these gains include the following:

River Valley Early Learning Center and River Valley Elementary

Academic Goal: By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, 100% of the RVE and RV-ELC students will increase in literacy and math proficiency by utilizing our MLSS structure, small group instruction, implementation of Top 10 Tools (Science of Reading professional development), and working on formative assessments. This progress will be measured through the use of district and state assessments.

Climate Goal: The Responsive Classroom Approach, Second Step, and Blackhawk Code will be used to ensure that 100% of the RVE/ELC students will have a connection with a trusted adult by the end of the 2023-24 school year. This progress will be measured by staff and student survey data and observation.



River Valley Middle School

Academic Goal: By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, 100% of the RVMS students will increase in literacy and math proficiency by utilizing our MLSS structure, small group instruction, posting standards-based learning targets in classrooms, and working on formative assessments. This progress will be measured through the use of district and state assessments.

Climate Goal: By the end of the 2023-2024 school year 100% of students will attain a sense of belonging at River Valley Middle School. This progress will be measured utilizing a connection survey, data for activity participation, and the YRBS (Youth Risk Behavior Survey).



River Valley High School

Academic Goal: *By the end of the 2023-24 school year, 100% of the RVHS educational staff will increase their use of strategies designed to improve academic proficiency of low socioeconomic students. These strategies will include small group instruction for all students, setting and posting learning outcome targets and refining our Co-Teaching Model. This progress will be measured through the use of formative and summative data.*

Climate Goal: *By the end of the 2023-24 school year 100% of students will attain a sense of belonging at River Valley High School. This progress will be measured utilizing the connection survey, data from activity participation, and surveys and observations from the Freshman AM Blackhawk period.*
