We are excited to invite you to experience the incredible transformation of the River Valley Middle School campus on Friday, September 27, 2024. The campus will be brimming with diverse student projects showcased in the gymnasium, engaging animal exhibits, an interactive agriculture experience, and vibrant vendor areas—all culminating in the highly anticipated livestock auction. Join us in supporting our talented youth at the auction, which begins at noon. Buyer registration will be open from 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Please visit the shed across from the pavilion to obtain your bidder's number. Animals will be sold in a predetermined order, regardless of their placement, and we will offer limited harvesting spots, which will be announced on the day of the auction. This year, buyers have three options for their purchases: Natural Harvest a division of Prem Meats, Straka Meats, or Equity Livestock. Currently, we have over 60 potential sellers for 2024. Straka Meats has room for 16 hogs and 2 steers and Natural Harvest a division of Prem Meats has room for 15 hogs and 2 beef.

The River Valley FFA's mission is to make a positive impact on students' lives by nurturing their leadership, personal growth, and career success through agricultural education. In alignment with this mission, FFA members, alumni, and local businesses have collaborated to provide an array of food stands, games, demonstrations, and educational displays. We encourage you to support these youth groups, who contribute so much to our community.
