School Calendar			<p>Glasbrenner presented updates from Staff Curriculum and Instruction priorities: curriculum documentation steps, standardized interim assessments, and professional learning time. The teacher team is researching interim assessment systems, but has concerns of when and how to implement changes without designated professional collaborative time. PLC (professional learning collaboration) was researched within CESA 3 districts with about 50% of districts reporting designated time weekly, bimonthly, or monthly. Glasbrenner created a Google survey which was previewed by the committee.</p> <p>Instructional time and days of instruction was discussed. The committee agreed to work within the 2022-23 school calendar to start and to provide training to teacher leaders throughout the summer. Professional development implications were also mentioned that PLC structures can and will take time and commitment. The Google survey created by Glasbrenner will be sent prior to the next committee meeting to gain staff feedback.</p> <p>No action by committee.</p>
Student Technology Survey			The committee reviewed the Student Technology Survey from 2019 question by question. The committee agreed to using the same questions to gather cleaner data of changes or growth. The survey will be sent to students in middle school and high school again this spring.
