Programs for Children at Risk

The Board shall establish programs to serve children in the River Valley School District who are identified at risk by Wisconsin statutory and district definitions.

All programs developed for children at risk shall be designed to:

- a. Improve and expand educational opportunities for these children on an individualized basis, through a variety of means;
- b. Provide alternative courses or program modifications which satisfactorily meet the school district graduation requirements;
- Encourage parental involvement;
- d. Encourage cooperation with community support service agencies; and
- e. Provide ongoing collaboration and evaluation between student, parent, staff, and administration.
- f. Per Early Literacy Instruction, Act 20, "at risk" means a student scored below the 25th percentile on a universal screening assessment or diagnostic assessment in grades K-3.

Students shall be identified and referred for evaluation to a building leadership team in accordance with state regulations and guidelines established by the Department of Public Instruction and the District
