Selection of Instructional Materials

The Board of Education shall provide instructional materials and equipment, ~~to provide adequate instructional materials, texts, and library services, which reflect the cultural diversity and pluralistic nature of American society. within budgetary constraints, to implement the District's educational goals and objectives and to meet students' needs. The primary objective of such instructional materials and equipment shall be to enrich, support, and implement the educational program of the school. Instructional materials shall be selected so that students may develop, under guidance, the practice of critical analysis and their intellectual integrity.~~

Although the Board is legally responsible for the operation of the school and recognizes the students' right to free access to many different types of information, the responsibility for the selection of instructional materials is delegated to the appropriate staff and administration.
