Fundraising Activities

Fundraising by approved school organizations, those whose funds are managed by the District, shall have prior approval from the Building Principal. Booster Clubs shall consult with the Activities Director when the use of students is involved. Other district support organizations shall consult with the District Administrator when the use of students is involved.

The District will permit student fundraising by students in school, on school property, or at any school-sponsored event only when the profit therefrom is to be used for school purposes for an activity connected with the schools. Door-to-door fund-raising activities (i.e. canvassing neighborhoods) are not encouraged.

Crowdfunding activities aimed at raising funds for a specific classroom or school activity, including co-curricular activities, or to obtain supplemental resources (e.g., supplies or equipment) that are not required to provide a free, appropriate, public education to any students in the classroom may be permitted, but only with the specific approval of the District Administrator Crowdfunding activities that do not involve revenue/proceeds being sent directly to the District will not be approved. Materials, supplies, equipment, and other proceeds of the crowdfunding activity shall become the property of the District.

Organizations involved in fund-raising activities are encouraged to provide opportunities for direct contributions.

The use of the name, logo, or any assets of the District, is prohibited without the specific permission of the Business Manager.
