Junior/Senior Privilege Request Form

River Valley High School believes in promoting positive behavior and hard work by our students. Through the Junior / Senior Privilege, students who demonstrate a high level of maturity and personal responsibility may use the Commons Area in the Cafeteria instead of going to their regularly assigned Study Hall. Seniors approved for this program will be permitted to leave campus during their lunch period an unlimited amount of times and Juniors approved can leave up to 10 times per semester. This program is a privilege, good for one semester and can be revoked at any time. (See detailed guidelines.)

Students earning Junior/Senior Privilege must comply with the following guidelines. Students not following these guidelines will be subject to consequences that may include immediate revocation of this privilege.

- 1) Student must earn Junior/Senior Privilege under the present system, which is based on teacher ratings in regards to students' work ethic, behavior and attendance.
- 2) Students will return a parent permission slip granting permission for the off campus portion of this policy. (Parents may revoke this permission if deemed necessary).
- 3) Students should leave campus within five minutes of their assigned lunch period and return on time for their next class.
- 4) Students may not spend their lunch period driving on or around the school campus (includes MS and ES)
- 5) Students are expected to conduct themselves in a responsible manner and be respectful to homeowners, merchants and their properties.
- 6) Students will not litter.
- 7) Students will adhere to all driving rules and regulations. Safety is a priority.
- 8) Students will follow school rules while off campus and are accountable to these rules.
- 9) Students are expected to exit and enter the school through the main front doors.
- 10) Students will be respectful of school personnel.
- 11) Students may not transport ineligible students.
- 12) Students may lose this privilege for disciplinary issues at school, school-related activities or during lunchtime release.
- 13) The Principal or Dean of Students can close the open campus release during emergencies and/or dangerous weather.
- 14) This privilege can be cancelled due to multiple complaints by homeowners, drivers, merchants, village personnel or school staff.
- 15) The Principal or Dean of Student's decisions on open campus privileges are final and non-negotiable. (this is a privilege, not a right)

Guidelines

- 1) This program is a privilege and not a guaranteed right.
- 2) A student must re-apply each semester.
- 3) The student will not be truant, will avoid discipline problems, will maintain a successful academic rigor and will be a responsible member of the student body.
- 4) A student may lose this privilege at any time.
- 5) A student who violates school policy and/or allows his/her academic rigor to drop will lose this privilege for one week on the first offense. (A major infraction may result in automatic loss of the privilege on a first offense.)
- 6) A student who violates school policy and/or allows his/her academic rigor to drop a second time will lose the privilege for the remainder of the semester.

Added Guidelines for Leaving Campus at Lunch

- 7) Students should leave campus within five minutes of their assigned lunch period and return on time for their next class.
- 8) Students may not spend their lunch period driving on or around the school campus (includes MS/ES)
- 9) Students are expected to conduct themselves in a responsible manner and be respectful to homeowners, merchants and their properties.
- 10) Students will not litter.
