Education for Homeless Children – Student Placement Dispute Form

A homeless child or youth has the right to remain at his or her school of origin (public school that the child attended when permanently housed, or the public school in which the child was last enrolled) or to attend any public school that other students who live in the attendance area are eligible to attend. If the student is eligible to attend more than one school, parents/caregivers or unaccompanied youth will have the option of choosing the school they wish to attend.

When a dispute arises over school placement, the parent/caregiver or unaccompanied youth will complete a *Student Placement Dispute* form and submit it to the Pupil Services Director for determination. After a determination is made, a copy of the completed *Notification of Dispute Resolution* form will be provided to the individual. **Note:** The student will attend the school requested (school of origin or school of residence) by the parent/caregiver or unaccompanied youth until the dispute is resolved.
