INFORMATION ITEMS:

1. Public Comments - Public comments, ideas, and suggestions related to our school district will be welcomed. As a reminder to all Board members, this agenda item is for the public to speak to the Board.
2. 2020-21 School Health Services Annual Report - School Nurse Jordyn Wendhausen will provide an annual report on services provided during the school year. *(Forthcoming.)*
3. End of Semester Review of Achievement Gap Reduction (AGR) Program - Carla Peterson will provide an update.
4. Summary of 2021-22 Open Enrollment Applications - The number of new students who have applied for open enrollment for next year is 13 new IN and 20 new OUT. *(Sent.)* In addition, continuing open enrollment students will be 47 students IN and 124 students OUT.

Through a partnership with the Medford School District, we will offer a full-time virtual school option starting in 2021-22 for River Valley residents to attend the Rural Virtual Academy through Medford School District. Under this arrangement, students can still participate in co-curricular activities in person at River Valley since they are counted as our students. *(Sent.)*

1. Consent Agenda: Checks, Invoices, Receipts – May 2021; Open Session Meeting Minutes – May 13, 2021, Regular Meeting - (*Minutes and enrollments sent. Six financial reports forthcoming.*)
2. Consideration & Action on Appointment of Medical Advisor for 2021-22 - School Nurse Jordyn Wendhausen is recommending Dr. Furukawa as the district's medical advisor for 2021-22.
3. Consideration & Action on Board President Appointment to Fill Area 4 Board Seat Vacancy Due to Resignation – Since we did not have an eligible candidate file a letter of interest by the due date for the Area 4 Board seat vacancy, and May 10 was 60 days since the vacancy first existed, Board Policy #133 Filling Board Vacancies allows the Board President to appoint an eligible candidate to fill the seat until April 25, 2022. At the 2022 Spring election, a candidate will be elected to fill the remaining one year of the term, which expires in 2023. (*Sent.*)
4. Consideration & Action on 2021-22 Board Committee Assignments - President Jennings will seat committees for the upcoming year. (*Policies sent. Assignments forthcoming.*)
5. Consideration & Action on Reinstatement of Use of District Indoor Facilities by Non-School Groups and Visitors - In June 2020, the Board took action to keep district facilities closed to non-school groups after June 30 until further notice. In April, the Board took action to allow non-school groups to use outdoor facilities. The Board will now consider access to indoor facilities and allowing visitors.
