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Automated Lunch/Breakfast Program

The District uses an automated lunch accounting system to record food service payments and to monitor food purchase transactions. The system functions as a debit system. Parents/guardians are expected to maintain their lunch account in a positive status. Any funds remaining in family lunch accounts at the end of the school year will carry over to the next school year. Refunds will be issued upon written parental request.

Students will be issued an identification number and assigned a lunch account that the automated lunch accounting system will monitor.

The District receives federal and state reimbursement in the form of cash and commodities for the first lunch served to each student. Second lunches and extra portions are available at a la carte prices.

In accordance with Federal civil rights law and U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) civil rights regulations and policies, the USDA, its Agencies, offices, and employees, and institutions participating in or administering USDA programs are prohibited from discriminating based on race, color, national origin, sex, religious creed, disability, age, political beliefs, or reprisal or retaliation for prior civil rights activity in any program or activity conducted or funded by USDA.

Additionally, program information may be made available in languages other than English.
