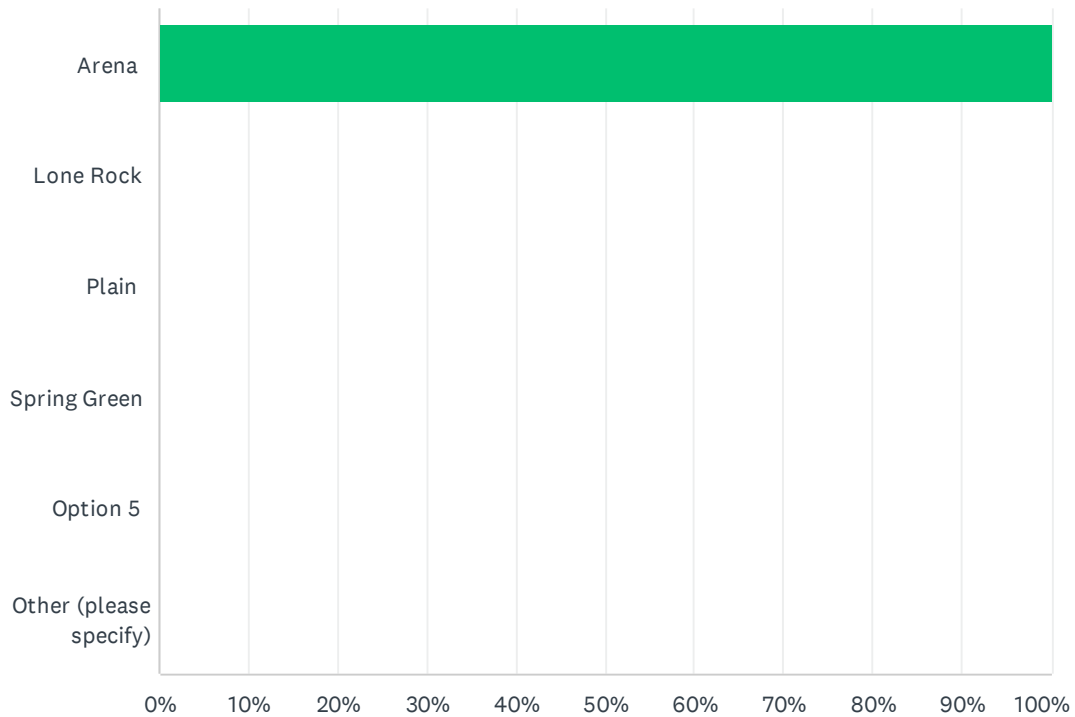


## Q1 In which community do you reside?

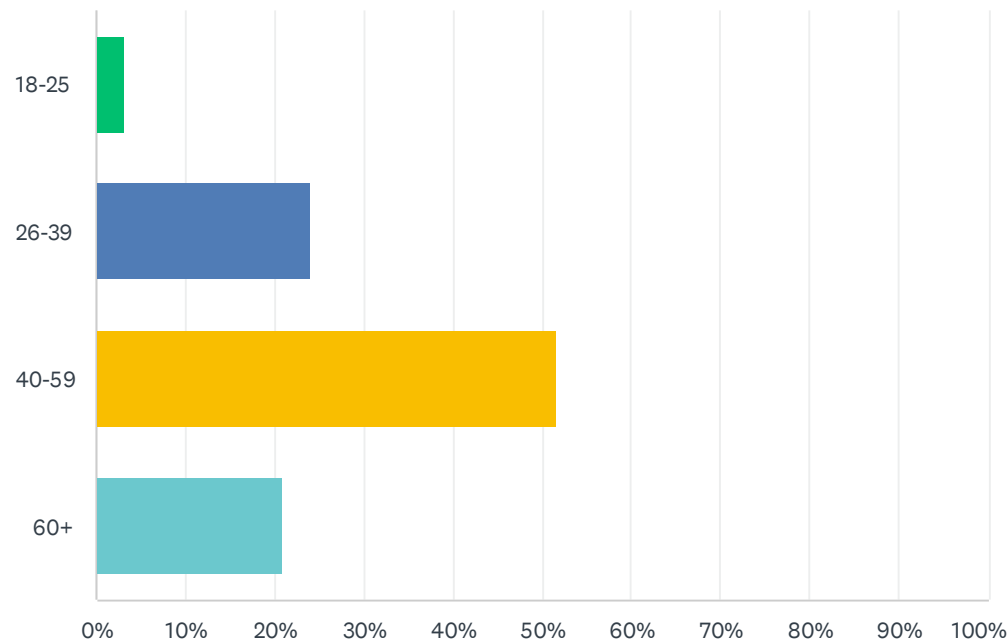

## Q2 What is your age?

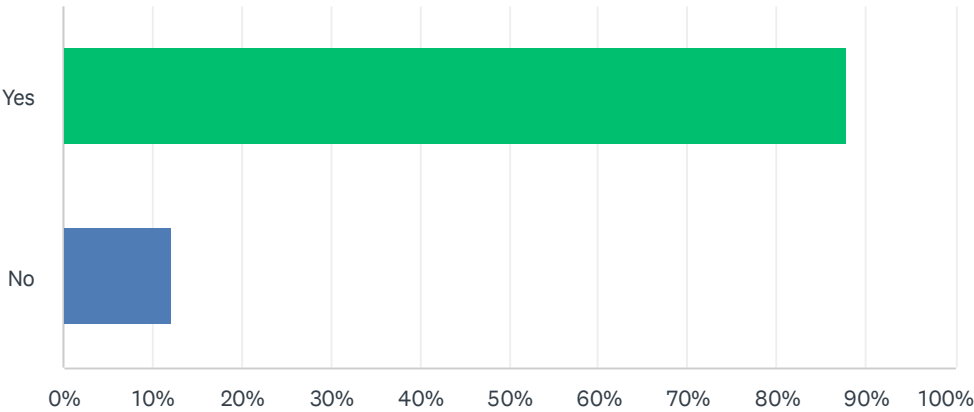

### Q3 Did you vote on April 2nd?

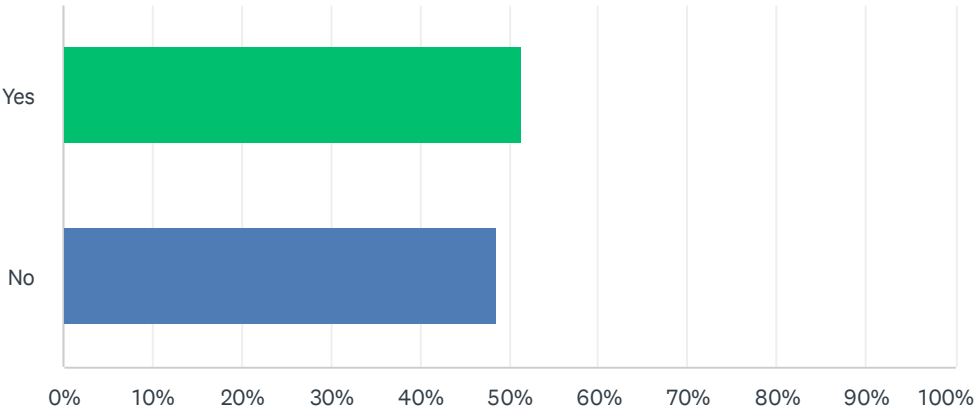

Q4 On Question 1 (\$19.5 million for school facility improvement projects across the district), how did you vote?

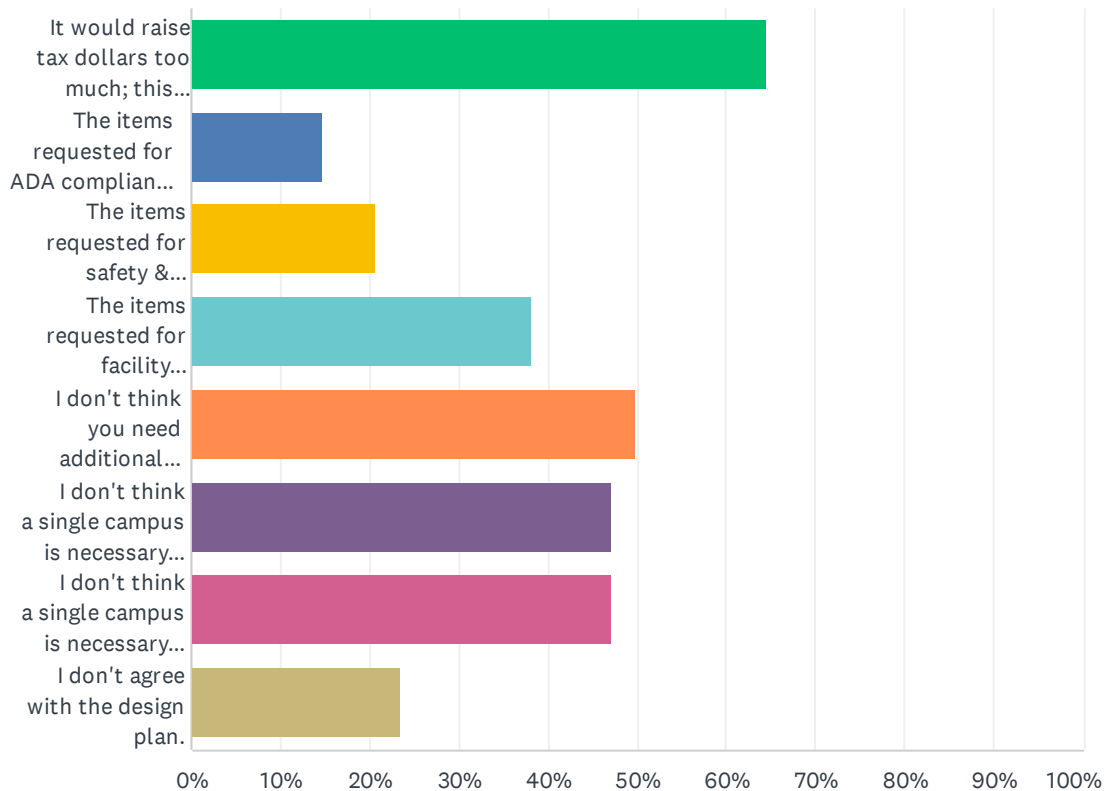

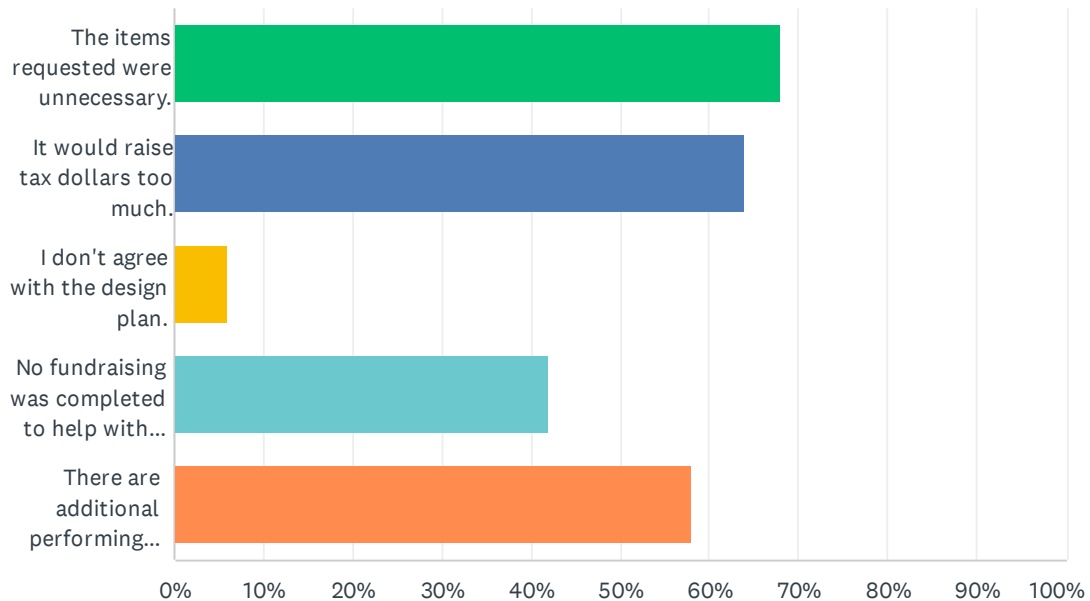
