

Changes to the At-Risk Handbook:

-The handbook is now made up of four different sections: Definitions of at-risk areas, goals of the program, the identification process, and supports that are available. The document was consolidated into these four sections to make it more use-friendly.

-Items that were deleted included specific supports for the different at-risk areas because each student has an individualized plan based on their needs. Specially designed work experience options are not used at this time and deleted from the handbook. Lack of motivation was changed to lack of engagement, and booster classes were added as RTI programming at the high school level.
