

Changes to the At-Risk Handbook June of 2023

-Took out the section for the middle school at-risk program because there is no longer an at-risk program at the middle school. There is, however, reading and math interventionists for those needing academic support.

-Under Multi-Level System of Supports on page 4, added language after the first sentence to read: "Curriculum modification, adapted instructional strategies, and pupil support services are also available to all students who need additional support."

-Added another support, now number 2 on page 4: "School to work programs that are supervised by licensed school personnel."

-Changed Page 4, Number 5 to booster classes offered in English (no longer offered in math); added Number 6, Page 4 which states that workshops for high school credit are offered in math.

-Took out the names of the business manager and pupil services director in the nondiscrimination statement at the end of the document
