

River Valley Elementary and Early Learning Center



On May 26, 2022 River Valley Early Learning Center conducted a lockdown safety drill. Teachers and students were notified in advance, with extra consideration for students that may have some anxieties about this kind of drill. The drill was initiated at 8:40 with the following announcement "Your attention please. This is a drill. We are in lockdown. Teachers, lock your doors and keep students in your room until further notice. Students or staff should go into the nearest classroom or office. Ignore all alarms and bells unless advised otherwise." The drill was concluded less than 3 minutes later at approximately 8:43 with an "All clear" announcement.

Students are trained to follow the teacher's directions and move to a safe area in the classroom. Teachers locked doors, covered inside windows, took attendance, and spoke guietly with their students in order to help the children remain calm. Being very cognizant of our youngest learners, teachers were prepared to handle the childrens' fears appropriately. During the drill, all doors were checked. All were found to be secured.

There were 121 students and 23 adults present for this drill.

Successful highlights:

Staff and students responded well. It was a good learning experience.

Focus areas for the next drill:

One classroom was quite loud and two classrooms had forgotten to dim the lights. This will be addressed with the staff.
