Title Relationship with Eau Claire Public Schools Foundation

Code 840.1

Adopted May 4, 2020

The Board recognizes the value of its relationship with the Eau Claire Public Schools Foundation (ECPSF) and adopts this policy to establish the parameters of the relationship and otherwise make a commitment to the continuation of the strong partnership supporting the District and its schools.

Accordingly, the relationship with the ECPSF shall be governed by the following terms:

- 1. The District shall permit the ECPSF to use the District's facilities for ECPSF purposes in a manner consistent with District policies and procedures.
- 2. The Board shall consider ECPSF requests for operational or funding support on an as needed basis.
- 3. To the extent allowed under state and federal law, the District shall provide ECPSF access to directory information for students and their parents/quardians.
- 4. The ECPSF Executive Director may attend Board meetings, retreats, and strategic planning sessions as requested by the Superintendent for purposes of providing financial, operational, planning, and fundraising updates.
- 5. The Superintendent or designee shall be invited to all ECPSF Board meetings but shall not be a member of the ECPSF Board.
- 6. The ECPSF shall provide donor and gift information to the District to ensure compliance with applicable laws governing the donation of money or materials to the District.
- 7. The District shall be responsible for acknowledging any and all gifts, donations, and support in a manner consistent with ECASD Board policies and procedures.
- 8. The District shall follow all ECASD Board policies and procedures including, without limitation, procurement policies in relation to the utilization of gifted or donated funds.
- The District shall be responsible for any media or social media statements in relation to gifts, donations, and support. The ECPSF shall seek the District's input on any public comment regarding gifts, donation, or support.
- 10. As ECASD develops the budget each year, it is possible that needs will be identified for which the District would need fundraising assistance. ECASD will make these requests to the ECPSF to assist with fulfilling the needs.
- 11. The ECPSF shall be operated as an entity completely separate and distinct from the District and shall maintain its own fiduciary, liability, fidelity, and errors and omissions insurance. The ECPSF shall provide the District with evidence of insurance coverage upon the District's reasonable request.
- 12. If the ECASD Board transfers management of any donated funds to ECPSF, the ECASD Board and ECPSF shall enter into a written agreement pursuant to, and consistent with, Wis. Stat. § 118.27(3).
